Dear Sir

I have prepared a translation  
of your memoir on Ophryocystis  
for publication in the "Annals &  
Magazine of Natural History," and  
I wrote some weeks ago to Mr.  
Reinwald to ask whether we  
could have for its illustration  
the necessary number of  
impressions of the plate which  
accompanied the memoir in  
the "Archives de Zoologie";  
requesting him at the same  
time to communicate either with

you or with M. de Lacaze -  
Duthiers, to obtain permission  
to furnish us with what we  
required. -

As I have had no answer  
from him, I venture now to  
apply directly to yourself, in the  
hope that you will kindly  
interest yourself to procure  
for us what impressions are  
wanted. - It will manifestly  
be much better to illustrate the  
paper with impressions from  
the original plate, than to have  
the figures copied here, more  
especially as the comprehension  
of the matters treated of depends  
so much upon the figures. -  
If the business can be managed

I will furnish the lithographers  
in Paris with a note of the  
necessary alterations in the  
lettering of the plate and of the  
number of impressions required. -

Enclosed is a proof of the  
translation not yet corrected, &  
I shall be obliged by any remarks  
or suggestions that you may wish  
to make upon it. -

that you will kindly favour  
me with an answer, whether
