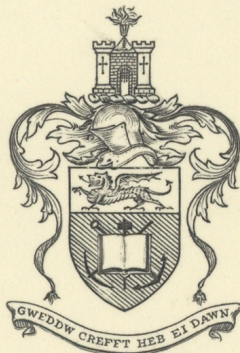

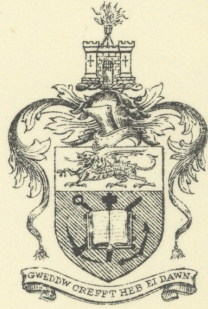
I am interested in the development of M. Padé's work on the representation of a function by means of a continued fraction, and find that you have contributed much recent work to this subject.
