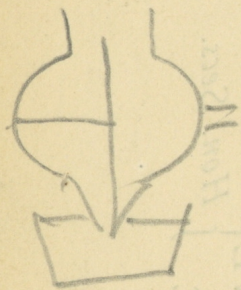
On receipt of your Entrance Fee and first Subscription (or Life Composition) the Proceedings of the Society commencing at ~~No. Vol III~~ will become due to you.
